

Target Applicants for the UCAR Next Generation Fellowship

From racial/ethnic groups traditionally underrepresented in the geosciences: African American, Chicano/Latinx, Native American, Filipino, Pacific Islander, Southeast Asian (i.e. Cambodian, Hmong, Laotian, Vietnamese) or mixed race/multiracial groups with at least one parent from the above ethnicities.

First-generation college students: This means that neither one of your parents received a bachelor's or 4-year degree (or higher) from an accredited college or university in the United States. If you have a sibling in college you are still first generation. If your parents took some courses, but did not complete a degree you are still considered first generation;

From a low-income family: (e.g. qualified for Free or Reduced Lunch program while in high school).

Sexual/Gender minorities: This means that you identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, queer, asexual, demisexual, or some other sexual minority, and/or you are transgender, and/or you identify your gender as non-binary, genderfluid, genderqueer, or some gender other than "male" or "female".

Students with disabilities: This means that you have a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activity.

Veterans: You have served in the active military, naval, or air service, and you were discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable.
